

BRIGADIER GENERAL TROY D. HAVENER

Brig. Gen. Troy D. Havener is the Air National Guard Assistant to the Commander, United States Air Forces in Europe - Air Forces Africa (USAFE-AFAFRICA). General Havener is responsible for advising the Commander, USAFE-AFAFRICA regarding missile defense and air operations across three combatant commands and 104 nations in Europe, Africa and the Middle East. He also leads the Command's National Guard State Partnership Program engagements and Air National Guard participation in theater operations and exercises.

Brig. Gen. Havener was commissioned in 1993 as a graduate of the United States Air Force Academy. He served over nine years in the active-duty Air Force and then joined the Air National Guard in 2002. He has served in the Iowa, Minnesota, California, Nevada and South Dakota Air National Guard, and has been part of National Guard Bureau Staff. He commanded the Air National Guard Distributed Training Operations Center, and he served as 144th Fighter Wing Commander. Prior to his current position, the general was the Chief of Staff, South Dakota Air National Guard.

Brig. Gen. Havener is a command pilot with more than 3,600 flying hours in the F-16C/D, F15C/D, AT-38B, T-38, and T-37, including more than 350 combat hours.
